**Clean dryer vents.** Making sure your dryer vents, lines and screens are free of lint to PREVENT fire.

2



**Clean the condenser coils on your refrigerator** at least every 3-6 months (more often if you have pets). When coils are dirty or dusty, your fridge has to work harder, which means higher power bills and shorter life expectancy.

**Clean your gutters, remove twigs, leaves,** and any other debris out of the gutters to ensure proper water flow. Visually inspect downspouts and make sure they are securely attached.

**Clean your oven hood vent screen** by soaking the screen overnight in degreaser soap.

5



**Drain garden hoses and shut off valve to exterior faucets** BEFORE freezing temperatures. If you have an in-ground sprinkler system, make sure it is properly drained and winterized.

6



**Check in the cabinet beneath each faucets for leaking.** Clean and freshen sink drains by flushing with a diluted bleach and water mix, or with warm water and baking soda.

7



**Never have 2 extension cords connected together.** Do not use space heaters with extension cords. Keep space heaters at least 3 ft. away from any combustible materials such as bedding, clothing, draperies, furniture and rugs.
